Information & Updates to Share

- Families of students who ride the bus, please seat your child on the bus according to the seating chart and name tags. It is part of our safety plan that students sit in their assigned seats. If you are not sure where your child should sit on the bus, please ask the bus driver for help.

- Please help us maintain a safe school and a safe and orderly arrival & dismissal time. Please do not pull into the ELC Kiss-n-Ride lane until after 10:25 a.m. and 2:15 p.m. This lane is our EMERGENCY/FIRE lane and there is NO PARKING in this lane. If you are parked here prior to these times, you will be asked to exit the lane. During arrival and dismissal, there is no parking in the ELC parking lot, aside from those with disability parking placards or plates. Please do not arrive at the parking lot prior to it being closed with the intention of parking in the lot for arrival and/or dismissal. You will be asked to exit the lot and join the Kiss-n-Ride lane or park on the street.
- **September 2 Bus Safety Drill:** If your child rides the bus to school, they will participate in a bus safety drill. Our bus drivers will be sharing information about bus safety, and students will practice exiting the bus in a safe manner.
- **September 6:** There is no school due to the Labor Day holiday.
