Dear ELC Families,

- Fever above 100.4°F

- · New onset of severe headache
- Respiratory symptoms (new uncontrolled cough, shortness of breath)
- Note: For students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their baseline. Seasonal or environmental allergy and asthma symptoms are not considered acute respiratory illness.
- Gastrointestinal symptoms (sore throat, vomiting or diarrhea)
- · New loss of taste or smell

- Since COVID-19 vaccinations are not currently available for children under 12 years of age, the approved CCSD59 Return to School Plan includes the requirement for all students, staff, and visitors to wear masks while in our school buildings.

- If your child needs to stay home due to COVID-19 (symptoms and/or a

 Gonzalez, ELC Coach. Mrs. Gonzalez will provide your student with athome learning during the time they are out of school due to needing to
 quarantine.
- Within the next few weeks students will be bringing home their tablets.
