### Vaccine Clinic

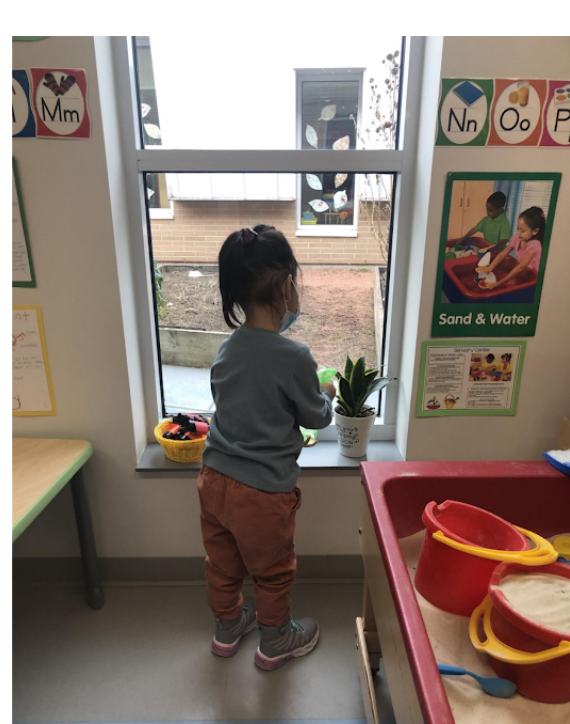
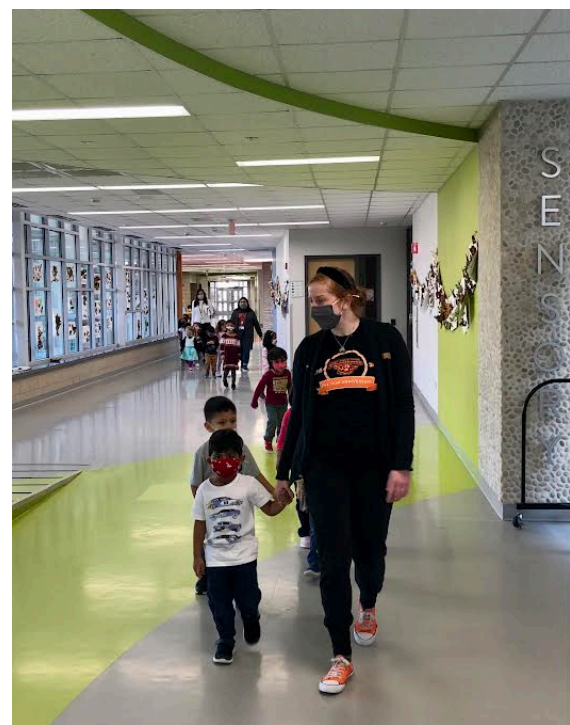
